St Scholastica class trip to' WhereTheWall' Bristol on Monday 21st May 2018

We have organised a trip for St Scholastica class to visit a professional Street Art company in Bristol on Monday 21st May 2018. This is an essential part of our topic work being covered in class. It will give the children an opportunity to be taken on a city centre street art tour, followed by a Banksy-style spray-paint art workshop session.

This trip will be outside school hours. The coach will be leaving Malmesbury Cross Hayes outside church at 8.35am so please ensure your child is dropped by 8.30am ready for a prompt departure. The coach will return before the end of school so pick up of your child will be as usual. We ask that children are dressed in their school PE kits, including their long tracksuit bottoms, comfortable trainers and a warm coat if it is cold weather. A packed lunch will need to be provided for the day with drinks in suitable containers. May we remind you **not** to send your child with a glass drinking bottle, fizzy drink or yoghurt type food. Please also note that eating and drinking is not permitted on any of our coaches.

We are asking parents for a contribution of **£22.20** to fund the cost of the trip. Whilst the contribution is voluntary, we would point out that the trip would not be viable if not enough funds are raised as we have to pay for the coach and entry fees. **Please do speak to me should you have any questions or difficulties with payment.** Payment can be made by cheque (made payable to St Joseph's Catholic Primary School), cash or BACS. If payment is made by BACS, details are below. Please ensure that the Pay Reference clearly states the trip name and that of the child:
