We are delighted to announce that the annual Summer Fete hosted by the PFA will take place on **Saturday 23rd of June** from **11am to 1.30pm** in school. The Summer Fete is our end of school year celebration event for the whole school community as well as an important fundraiser. Our mission....

The PFA have agreed to cover the first instalment of £4k from existing funds and so we ideally need to raise a further £5k. This is an exciting challenge that will be made possible by everyone getting involved. We would like to warmly welcome new parents and carers or anyone who has not previously been involved. Every contribution is valued and there are lots of ways to take part.

We are asking every family to:
