A couple of them have been witnessed as being so engrossed in their phone, they have not been focusing on the road and the traffic. One pupil even stepped off the kerb as a car was coming! This is of course making my heart skip a beat! Our advice to pupils has been that the phone should be in their school bag on the way to/from school and is there only for an emergency situation. The children are certainly not allowed for their phone to be out of their bag on school premises. They are taken off the children at registration and locked away until the end of the day. I strongly urge parents to ensure they speak to their children about road safety in particular - if a child is putting themselves in danger by having a phone, perhaps they are not ready to have one!
