St Anthony	Christmas Shopping Stall	This is where the children can do their Christmas shopping for Mum and Dad, etc. So, we need small gifts that can be sold for £1 or so each . Handmade/homemade things are great or festive tea lights, chocolates, small Christmas decorations, glass jar of sweets or unwanted gifts you'd like to go to a new home!
St Aldhelm	Children's Tombola	Any new or unused game, book or toy or similar, e.g. set of marker pens, pack of cards, stationery set, etc.
St Lawrence	Adult Bottle Tombola	A bottle of something nice , e.g. wine, beer, fancy soft drink or cordial, olive oil, balsamic vinegar, etc.
St Francis	Adult Bottle Tombola	
St Scholastica	Luxury hamper	A selection of food items: Chocolates, mince pies, fancy jam, honey, mulled wine mix, toiletries, biscuits, wine, etc.
