## St Scholastica class trip to Arctic Quest, Tewkesbury, Gloucestershire on Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> February 2019

We have organised a trip for St Scholastica class to visit Arctic Quest near Tewkesbury next term. This will be a fantastic learning experience to complement their topic, Frozen Kingdom; we will take part in husky rides and find out about life in their natural habitat!

This trip will be outside normal school hours but children should come into school at the usual time as we won't be leaving Malmesbury Cross Hayes until mid-morning. We will return to the church courtyard at Cross Hayes, at approximately 4.30pm where you will be able to collect your child. We ask that children are all warmly dressed in their PE kits, including trainers and jogging bottoms, plus a warm coat, hat and gloves. Wellies (named) in a plastic carrier bag and a warm pair of socks should also be brought into school for the trip. A packed lunch will need to be provided for the day with drinks in suitable containers. May we remind you **not** to send your child with a glass drinking bottle, fizzy drink, yoghurt, sweets, chocolate or unhealthy snacks. Please also note that eating and drinking is not permitted on any of the coaches.

We are asking parents for a contribution of £33.20 to fund the cost of the trip. To date, this academic year, St Scholastica have had no topic-related trips involving costs to parents and Mr Dawson does not plan any more trips until the summer. Please do speak to us in the office should you have any questions or difficulties with payment. Payment can be made by cheque, cash or BACS. If it is made by BACS, please ensure that the Pay Reference clearly states the trip name and that of the child. The trip will not be viable if not enough funds are raised.
