Memorable Experience -

Make a giant iceberg!

Freeze water in a large balloon or clear plastic bag overnight. Once frozen, remove and place in a large container of water.

Observe how the iceberg sits in the water and how it changes over time.

Explore questions such as 'What happens if you add salt to the iceberg? Why do you think there are air bubbles in your iceberg? Why do you think the ice moves as it melts? Is there anything else that you want to try out on your iceberg? Which part melts more quickly - the part above or below the surface?'
