St Lawrence class trip to Stonehenge on Tuesday 23rd April 2019

We have organised an exciting trip for St Lawrence class for next term. This is an essential part of our topic work being covered in class where we will be learning about prehistoric times and how the people of Britain have developed over thousands of years. It will give the children the opportunity to take part in a Neolithic Life Discovery workshop, to walk around the stone circle and explore the exhibitions in the Visitor Centre.

This trip will be outside normal school hours. Children should come into school at the usual time in the morning and we ask that you pick up from the church courtyard at Cross Hayes at 3.45pm. Children should be suitably dressed in their PE kits, including trainers, jogging bottoms and a warm coat. A packed lunch and a snack will need to be provided for the day with drinks in suitable containers. May we remind you **not** to send your child with a glass drinking bottle, fizzy drink or yoghurt. Please also note that eating and drinking is not permitted on any of the coaches and in line with our healthy eating guidelines, sweets and chocolate should be avoided.

We are asking parents for a contribution of **£16.70** to fund the cost of the trip. The trip will not be viable if not enough funds are raised as we have to pay for the coach and entrance/workshop. Please do speak to the office staff or myself, should you have any questions or difficulties with payment.
