St Aldhelm and St Lawrence Class Trip to Lyme Regis on Tuesday 11th June 2019

We have organised a very exciting joint class trip to Lyme Regis in Dorset for next term. This is an essential part of our topic work which will be covered in class where we will be learning about beaches, coastlines and fossils.

<u>Coach</u>: This will be an early start. Please drop your child at St Aldhelm's Church courtyard, Cross Hayes, at 8.35am ready for a prompt departure. You should collect your child from Cross Hayes at 4.45pm. Please keep an eye on Class Dojo in the afternoon as we will update you on the return time during our journey home.

<u>Clothes</u>: Children should be suitably dressed in their PE kits, including trainers, jogging bottoms and a coat. A spare set of clothes, shoes and socks, plus a small hand-towel might be a good idea to include in a separate plastic carrier bag in case they get wet. Depending on the weather, a sun hat or warm hat and gloves may be a good idea. Please ensure your child has had sun-cream applied as it can be very sunny and windy on the coast.

<u>Lunch</u>: A packed lunch and additional snacks will need to be provided for the day in a small backpack with at least two drinks in suitable containers. May we remind you **not** to send your child with a glass drinking bottle, fizzy drink or yoghurt. Please also note that eating and drinking is not permitted on the coach and in line with our school healthy eating guidelines, sweets and chocolate should be avoided.

<u>Ice-Creams</u>: If your child would like an ice-cream on the day, they should bring up to £3 in a named purse or envelope. If your child does not bring in any money, we will assume that you have not given permission for them to have one.

<u>Cost</u>: We are asking parents for a contribution of £10.55 to fund the trip cost. The trip will not be viable if not enough funds are raised. Please do speak to the office staff or myself, should you have any questions or difficulties with payment.

If you think you are entitled to Pupil Premium Free School Meals, please contact the school office and you may be able to have part or all of this trip funded by the school. To check on your eligibility follow this link: http://www.wiltshire.gov.uk/schools-learning-free-school-meals
