Dear Parents

St Scholastica Class Trip to Swindon on Friday 12th July 2019

We have organised an end of year treat for our year sixes to celebrate the end of their time at St Joseph's. They will be going to Swindon to participate in a variety of activities – Laser Quest, trampolining, ten-pin bowling and visiting an amusement arcade. We will have lunch at Pizza Hut so there will be no need to bring packed lunches, but children should bring a water bottle.

Children should be dropped off for school in the morning at the normal time. The coach will return to Cross Hayes at 5.30pm where parents are requested to pick up promptly. Children should be suitably dressed in their PE kits, including trainers, jogging bottoms and a coat. Please provide your child with drinks in suitable containers; snacks can also be brought. Please note that eating and drinking is not permitted on any of the coaches and in line with our school guidelines, sweets, chocolate and fizzy drinks should not be brought on the trip. Children are welcome to bring up to £6 to spend in the arcade.

We are asking parents for a payment of **£22.80** to fund the cost of the trip. The trip will not be viable if not enough funds are raised as we have to pay for the coach and entry fees.
