## St Francis Class trip to the Bath Children's Literature Festival on Friday 4th October 2019

We have organised a trip for St Francis class to visit the Bath Children's Literature Festival. This is an essential part of our topic work being covered in class and we will have the fantastic opportunity to participate in an author workshop with the authors Greg James and Chris Smith.

This trip will be outside normal school hours. Please drop your child at the usual time in the morning as the coach will not be leaving until after our first lesson. The coach is scheduled to return to the church courtyard, Cross Hayes, at 4pm so please arrange for pick-up there. Children should be suitably dressed in their PE kits, including trainers, jogging bottoms and a coat. A packed lunch and snack will need to be provided for the day with drinks in suitable containers. May we remind you **not** to send your child with a glass drinking bottle, fizzy drink or yoghurt. Please also note that eating and drinking is not permitted on any of the coaches and in line with our school healthy eating guidelines, sweets and chocolate should be avoided.

We are asking parents for a contribution of **£15.60** to fund the cost of the trip. The trip will not be viable if not enough funds are raised as we have to pay for the coach and entry fees. Please do speak to the office staff or myself, should you have any questions or difficulties with payment.
