Uniform Sales

2019 Y6 Residential Trip

The Residential Trip to Kilvrough Manor on the Gower Peninsula next September for the new Year Sixes will be Monday 2nd September until Friday 6th September 2019. The cost per child will be £330 for the trip. More details will be communicated in due course.

2019 Y3 Residential Trip

Next year's Y3 residential trip has been provisionally booked for Monday 1st until Wednesday 3rd July and will cost £155 per child for the three days. Due to the uncertainty of the future of Braeside, we will not be able to confirm this trip until 28 November 2018.

School Gates

In the mornings we request that parents/carers wait with children until there is a member of staff on the gates when they are opened at 8.35am. Children should be on the playground by 8.45am ready for the start of school. Children need to be punctual as once the gates are closed, office staff have other tasks around the school and are not always at the desk to answer the buzzer to latecomers. In the afternoons, the gates are opened at 3.10pm. If parents are later than 3.25pm picking up, children will be taken to K&S After School Club where a charge will be made for childcare.

Trips & Workshops

Class trips and workshops are an important part of the introduction of the class topic for the term. To ensure these go ahead, we need to keep to tight deadlines for payments and return of medical forms by parents. Should you have any questions or problems at all, please talk to the class teacher or office staff as soon as possible. We need parents to respond ahead of the deadline given, as staff do not have time to continually chase. Outside organisations impose a deadline to us, by which time we need to have firm numbers and payment in order to go ahead and therefore avoid cancellations.
