As I am sure you are aware, last year we took Year 3 on a very successful short residential trip to Braeside in Devizes. In the summer we will be going back to Braeside where the children will experience a variety of team building activities and also improve their independence skills. The trip will take place from Monday 8th June to Wednesday10th June (two nights) and transport will be provided.

The cost of the trip will be £170/child. At this stage we are asking parents for a deposit of £70.00 to be paid by Friday 7th February 2019. We would be grateful if you could complete and return the attached slip with the deposit of £70.00 by Friday 7th February.
