Christ the Redeemer is a statue of Jesus Christ, in Rio de Janeiro. It is one of the largest statues in the world. It is 30 metres tall and made from soapstone.

It was created by French sculpture Paul Landowski. It took 9 years to build - beginning in 1922 and finishing in 1931.



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What are we doing this term?
