Our school cook has said she would be grateful for any donations of apples, both cookers and eaters, so she can make the children some of her special delicious apple crumble. Please bring apples in bags to the main school gate. Thank you!

Have you registered your child for a flu vaccination yet? The school nursing team visit us on Wednesday 7th October. Time is running out to access the site and register your consent or not to give consent.

Your child is due to be in Reception to Year 6 from September 2020 and they are therefore eligible for a Free Nasal Childhood Flu Vaccination.

Flu vaccination is one of the most effective interventions we have to reduce pressure on the health and social care system which is going to be more important than ever this year. For this reason, it is essential we deliver the vaccine to as many children as possible to prevent the spread of infection to those most at risk in society.

In light of the above we are expecting demand to be high and therefore we urge you to follow the below link to consent to your child's vaccination now.
