You must write neatly! *Example: home h ho hom home</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Spelling Rainbows</p> <p>Rainbow write eight of your spelling words. Write each word first in pencil. Then trace over each word three times. Each time you trace, you must use a DIFFERENT color.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Squiggly Spelling Words</p> <p>Choose ten spelling words. You are going to write them two times. Write them first in squiggly letters. Then write them once more in regular letters. Write neatly!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Colorful Words</p> <p>Write each of your spelling words.
