



W.A.L.T: To know how and why Muhammed is a special person to Muslims.

Whenever we mention or hear our beloved Prophet Muhammad's name, we always follow with, "Peace and blessings be upon him."








Allah sent Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings be upon him) as the last messenger to teach Islam to everyone.

Allah sent down the Qur'an to Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings be upon him) through angel Jibreel/Gabriel (peace be upon him).


The Qur'an was first sent down to Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings be upon him) when he was 40 years old.
















His Wife
