

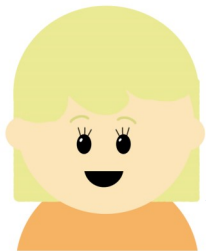

### YR3 Determiners

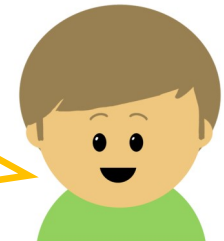
Three children are having a conversation about the use of determiners:
