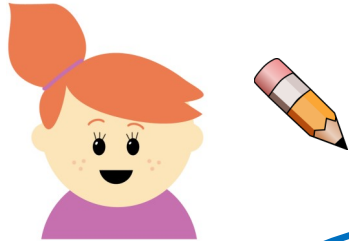

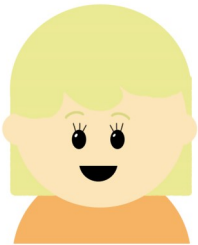
YR3 Tenses

Present Perfect / Simple Past Tense

Millie has written two sentences. Jane and Marlon are discussing her work.



Rufus has done his homework straight away.
Last week, he did his homework at the last minute.



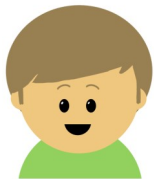
These sentences are
both about events
in the past.

But the verbs are
different; one says 'has
done' and the other says
'did'.



Can you explain how Millie has used different ways to write in the past tense?
