As we start term 3, we yet again find ourselves in uncertain times. There has been much talk in the news over the last week about school closures and the new variant of the virus. Firstly, I would like to extend a warm and heartfelt thank you for everyone's continued support, patience and understanding as we have been navigating our way through life in a Pandemic.

The current position of the school at present, and this could of course change at the last minute is, we as a school received no Section 44 letters from our staff and this meant that the school is able to open and able to continue to operate as safely as it can working within the risk assessments we have in place.
