### Reminder—procedure to request an absence from school.

Occasionally it may be necessary to formally request an absence from school, when this is the case, please complete and return a Leave of Absence Request Form, which can be found on the school website in Parents / Useful forms.

Examples for a request for absence could be:

exceptional family circumstance, such as a bereavement / religious observance / wedding of a close family member / family emergency

unavoidable medical / dental appointment (although it is the school's expectation that every effort should be made to secure routine doctor/dentist appointments out of school hours or during the holidays)

absence, within reason, for an external exam such as ballet and music and to attend elite events (e.g. National Youth Orchestra or a representative sport event)

At St Joseph's Catholic Primary School, we believe that every lesson is important & maximum attendance and punctuality are valuable life skills. Taking your child out of school during term time may harm your child's academic progress. In line with Local Authority policy, absences may only be authorised at the discretion of the Headteacher in **EXCEPTIONAL** circumstances.
