Providing Parental Permissions via Parentpay.

We are delighted that 99% of our parents are now using their Parentpay account for receiving school communications, booking and paying for school meals, making payments for school uniform and other items.

As the Covid restrictions continue to ease, there will be more opportunities for sporting tournaments, clubs and trips. With this in mind, we will be using the Parentpay Permissions function to electronically gain parental permissions for this.

This is very easy to do. If you can't find the easy click on permissions link, it will appear in the "trips/pay for other items" section—even if there is no cost to the visit/sporting event. The cost will appear as zero, but the permission still required.
