ELSA (Emotional Literacy Support Advisor)

Following the partial school closures due to the Coronavirus we have reflected upon the services St Joseph's provides to support children's mental health and well-being. We are delighted to tell you that we will be internally appointing an ELSA (Emotional Literacy Support Advisor) who will be a teaching assistant, specially trained to support children's emotional needs. Our ELSA will be working with children in small groups or 1:1 in many ways including sessions focusing on areas such as social skills development, developing resilience, emotional support and management.

St Joseph's community will also continue to receive support from Terry Jones, our PSA (Parent Support Advisor) who will work in our school every Thursday morning.

Ordering School Meals—School lunches are ordered via your ParentPay account and must be ordered at least one week in advance. The system will not allow you to order if there is not a clear 7 day booking period.

Join us to identify and build coping skills, to recognise the positive aspects of anxiety and develop a few strategies to help all feel less anxious and frustrated.

No childcare, no travelling and no parking problems, just you, your cuppa and a friendly space.


