To Year 5 and Year 6 parents. Please apply for 2 X performance tickets per family online using the link contained in our email.


School reports will be handed to parents on Friday 2nd July. We have also included our annual data check forms and ask that these are reviewed, signed and returned to us before the end of term. In view of GDPR, report envelopes will only be handed to parent/carers. If you are not available at the end of the day, reports can be collected from the school office.

Holidays in term time

At St Joseph's Catholic Primary School, we believe that every lesson is important & maximum attendance and punctuality are valuable life skills. Taking your child out of school during term time may harm your child's academic progress. In line with Local Authority policy, absences may only be authorised at the discretion of the Headteacher in EXCEPTIONAL circumstances.

Please note that family holidays will not count as a reason to authorise absence in term time, with the exception of the children of armed forces personnel on leave from active service. Leave of absence requests must be made at least 5 days in advance.

ABSENCE IN TERM TIME Important notice - If a pupil accumulates 10 or more sessions of unauthorised leave of absence within the previous 6 month period of a current academic year, the school must notify the Local Authority and a Penalty Notice will be issued to each parent for each child where that applies. A penalty of £120 will apply, if paid within 21 days this is reduced to £60. £120 21- 28 days. If after 28 days the penalty has not been paid, legal proceedings will be taken through the magistrates court for the unauthorised absence.


