

Welcome to our 100 Club!

The 100 Club is a great way for you to support the PFA whilst having a bit of a flutter!

The membership fee is just £2 per month – less than the price of a cup of coffeel This adds up to £24 per year and gives you the opportunity to win up to £50 each month in the 12 draws running from January through to December.

50% of the money raised goes directly to the PFA to support the school in providing so many excellent extracurricular activities for our children. Each month 25% of the money raised goes to 1st prize, 15% to 2nd prize and 10% to 3rd prize.

Based on one hundred members, 1st prize would be £50, 2nd prize would be £30 and $3^{\rm rd}$ prize would be £20.

To join in the fun simply fill out and sign a copy of the membership form. This grants you a membership number (allocated by us), qualifying you for the monthly draw.

The draw will take place on the last Friday of each month. If you win you will be notified by email and prize money will be paid via cheque, which can be collected from the school office.
