Welcome to our 100 Club!

The 100 Club is a great way for you to support the PFA whilst having a bit of a flutter!

The membership fee is just £2 per month – less than the price of a cup of coffee! This adds up to £24 per year and gives you the opportunity to win up to £50 each month in the 12 draws running from January through to December.

50% of the money raised goes directly to the PFA to support the school in providing so many excellent extracurricular activities for our children. Each month 25% of the money raised goes to 1st prize, 15% to 2nd prize and 10% to 3rd prize.

Based on one hundred members, 1st prize would be £50, 2nd prize would be £30 and 3^{rd} prize would be £20.

To join in the fun simply fill out and sign a copy of the membership form. This grants you a membership number (allocated by us), qualifying you for the monthly draw.

The draw will take place on the last Friday of each month. If you win you will be notified by email and prize money will be paid via cheque, which can be collected from the school office. The names of the winners will be published in the school newsletter, on the PFA Facebook page and on the PFA page on the school website.

Members are invited to join through November and December, and the first draw will take place on Friday 26th January. Membership forms will be available at the Christmas Bazaar on Saturday 2nd December, and from your friendly PFA or the school office.

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100 Club rules

Purpose

The purpose of the 100 Club is to raise funds. The money will be paid into the PFA bank account and used to meet funding requests from the school, providing equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils.

Rules

- 1. For a cost of £2 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number between one and 100.
- 2. A draw will be made every month with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize.
- 3. The prizes will total 50% of the monthly income.
- 4. This will be apportioned as: 1st prize of 25%, 2nd prize of 15% and 3rd prize of 10%
- 5. The 100 club is a private lottery and is open to all parents, carers, staff and friends of St Joseph's Catholic Primary School. Anyone aged 16 or over can join.
- 6. Numbers are limited to two per household.
- 7. Payments must be made by standing order (preferably annually) or via ParentPay. One month's notice is required for cancellation.
- 8. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
- 9. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
- 10. The draw shall be made on the last Friday of each month by a member of staff and witnessed by a member of the PFA.
- 11. Prize monies will be paid by cheque within one week of the draw.
- 12. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted in the school newsletter, on the PFA Facebook Page and on the PFA page on the school website.
- 13. The 100 club will be run by the PTA. In case of any dispute the decision of the committee is final.
- 14. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
- 15. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into PTA funds after six months.


