

Scripture summarised

Remembrance Sunday in the UK, observed on the second Sunday in November, honours those who served and diec in military conflicts, especially since the First World War. The day is marked by ceremonies at war memorials, churches, and cenotaphs, with the main service held at the Cenotaph in London. At 11 a.m., a two-minute silence commemorates the armistice of 11 November 1918. Wreaths of red poppies are laid as symbols of sacrifice, and prayers are offered across the UK—not only for the fallen but also for those suffering from war and violence today, asking God for peace, strength, and comfort.
