



Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Aldhelm's,

We hope you are ok wherever you are. We are delighted to be in touch with you through this newsletter.

We extend a warm welcome to all visitors and thank you for joining us in celebrating the Lord's love for us in the Holy Eucharist. There are no strangers here, just new friends you have not yet met!

Scripture summarised

The first reading features Moses urging the Israelites to hor our God's Law, as it grants them dignity, purpose, and a special identity, bringing blessings of long life, prosperity, and peace.

The Responsorial Psalm (Ps 18) calls us to love God, our strength and protector.

In the Gospel, a Scribe asks Jesus to summarize the Mosaic Law, and Jesus quotes the Shema, emphasizing wholehearted lo *i*e for God. He adds the command to "love your neighbor as yourself," showing that true religion involves loving both Gc d and others. Genuine love for our neighbors reflects and prc ves our love for God.

Assisted suicide bill before Parliament

Kim Leadbeater MP is introducing a bill to introduce assisted suicide, which will be voted on by MP; on the **29 November**. We know that assisted suicide laws in other jurisdictions have had devastating consequences for the poor, disabled and marginalised. 
