Artist Olafur Eliasson and geologist Minik Rosing used shock tactics to get their message across and created a large-scale public installation called 'Ice Watch' where they carefully arranged 24 blocks of glacial ice from Greenland's melting glaciers in front of the Tate Modern, an art gallery in London.
