

The first reading shows Stephen's martyrdom as a witnes; to Christ's forgiving love. Revelation presents Jesus as the Alpha and Omega, Lord of all, supporting us in our Christian witness. Though we long for unity with the saints, true unity with others remains a daily challenge. Today's Gospel features Jesus' final prayer before his Passion, often called his "High Priestly Prayer." He prays for himself, his disciples, and future believers—including us—asking for unity, protection, and faith. This prayer reveals Jesus' deep trust in the Father and his entrusting of us to God's care, giving us confidence in our Christian journey.
