Readings this Sunday

In the first reading, Isaiah comforts the returning exiles w th God's promise of care and restoration, like a mother nurturing her child. Paul, in the second reading, clarifies to the Galatians that salvation comes through Christ's sacrifice, not throug h Jewish law. He calls all Christians to witness to the cross through lives of service. In the Gospel, Jesus sends out 72 disciples to prepare the way for him, instructing them to live simply, trust in God's providence, and proclaim the Good News. Today, Christians share that same mission: to bring Christ's message of love and salvation to the world.

Carlo Acutis to be canonised on 7 September

Pope Leo XIV held the first Ordinary Public Consistory of his pontificate on Friday morning, 13 June, with Cardinals giving their formal approval for the canonisations of eight Blesseds.

During the ceremony, the Holy Father announced that London-born Blessed Carlo Acutis will be canonised on 7 September alongside Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati.

The canonisations of the two young saints – one from the early twentieth century, the other the first millennial saint – have been greatly anticipated due to the great devotion among the faithful.

Saturday 12th July at 11.00am – Jubilee Mass & Reception

Our Jubilee Mass will be celebrated here in church at 11am. We are delighted to welcome Mgr Lian Slattery, Vicar General of Clifton Diocese, who will preside at the Eucharist, and Fr Johnson Kaliduki MSFS, Superior General of the Missionaries of St Francis de Sales, who will preach. Fr Johnson is joining us especially for this occasion.

At this celebration, we will also be releasing the title of our commemorative parish history book. The book is nearly ready, though we won't yet have the printed copies in hand, as the printing process is taking a little longer than expected.

You are warmly invited to join us for all parts of the celebration: the Evening Prayer on the day befc re, the Mass, and the reception at the Town Hall afterwards on both occasions. SM is an agency of the Catholic Church whose outreach involves spiritual and pastoral, practical and welfare, education and campaigning work in support of all seafarers, regardless of their nationality, colour or creed.

SM supports seafarers through a network of chaplains and ship visitors; lay and ordained, paid and volunteer, who proactively visit seafarers on their ships offering the hand of friendship; run ecumenical drop-in centres in ports where seafarers can relax and contact their families by phone or email; and accompany seafarers on their voyages as seagoing chaplains.
