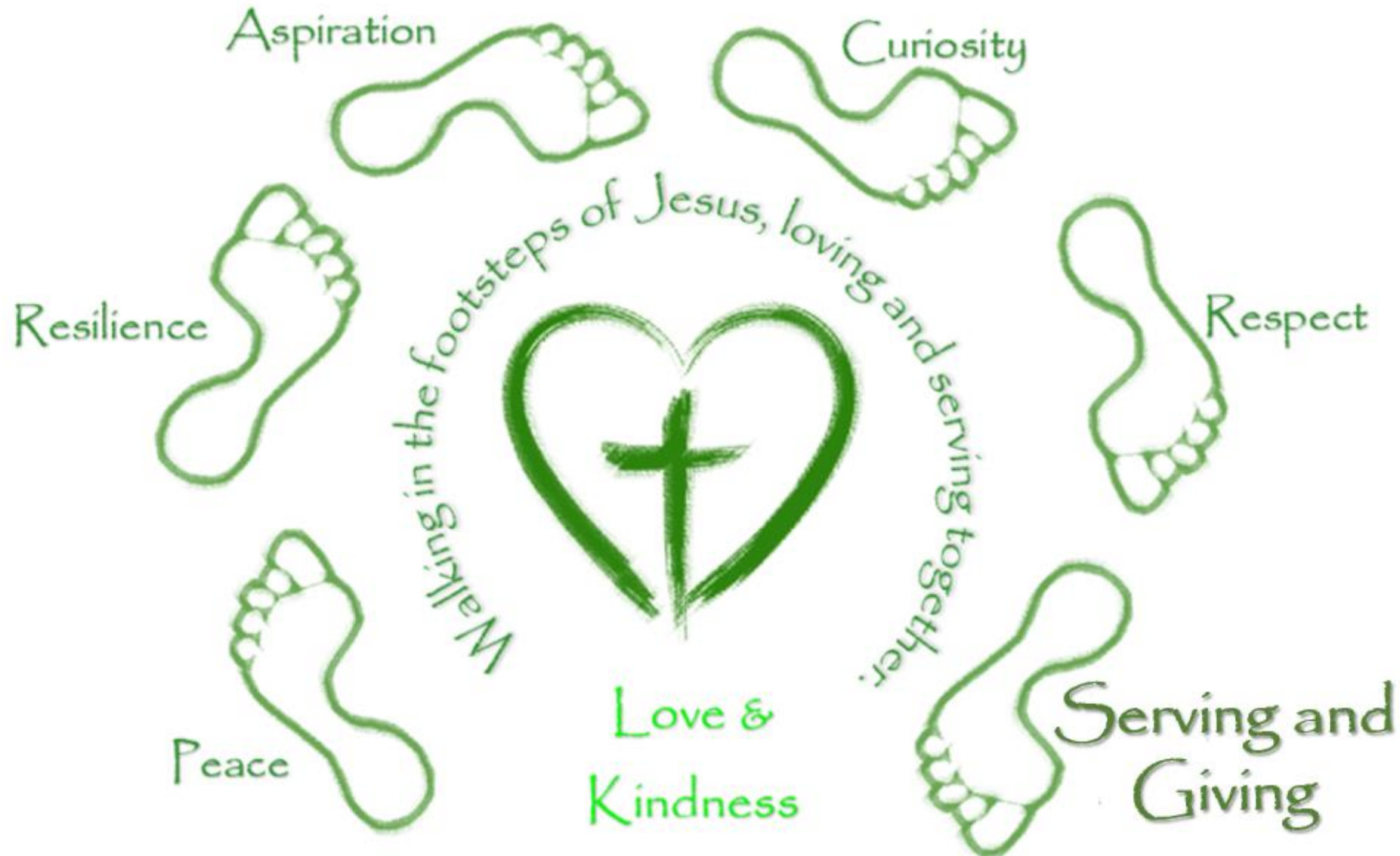
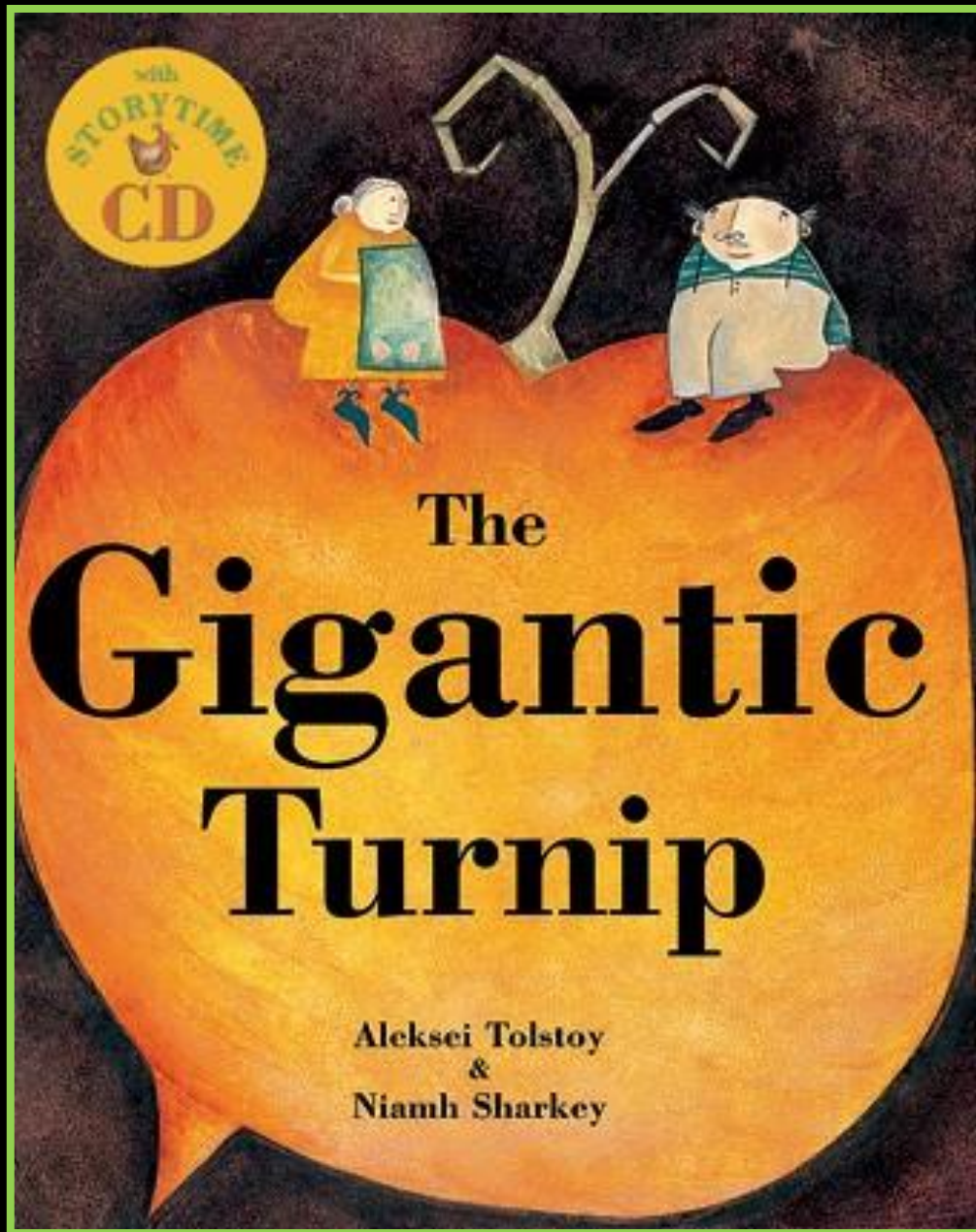

give that is important.

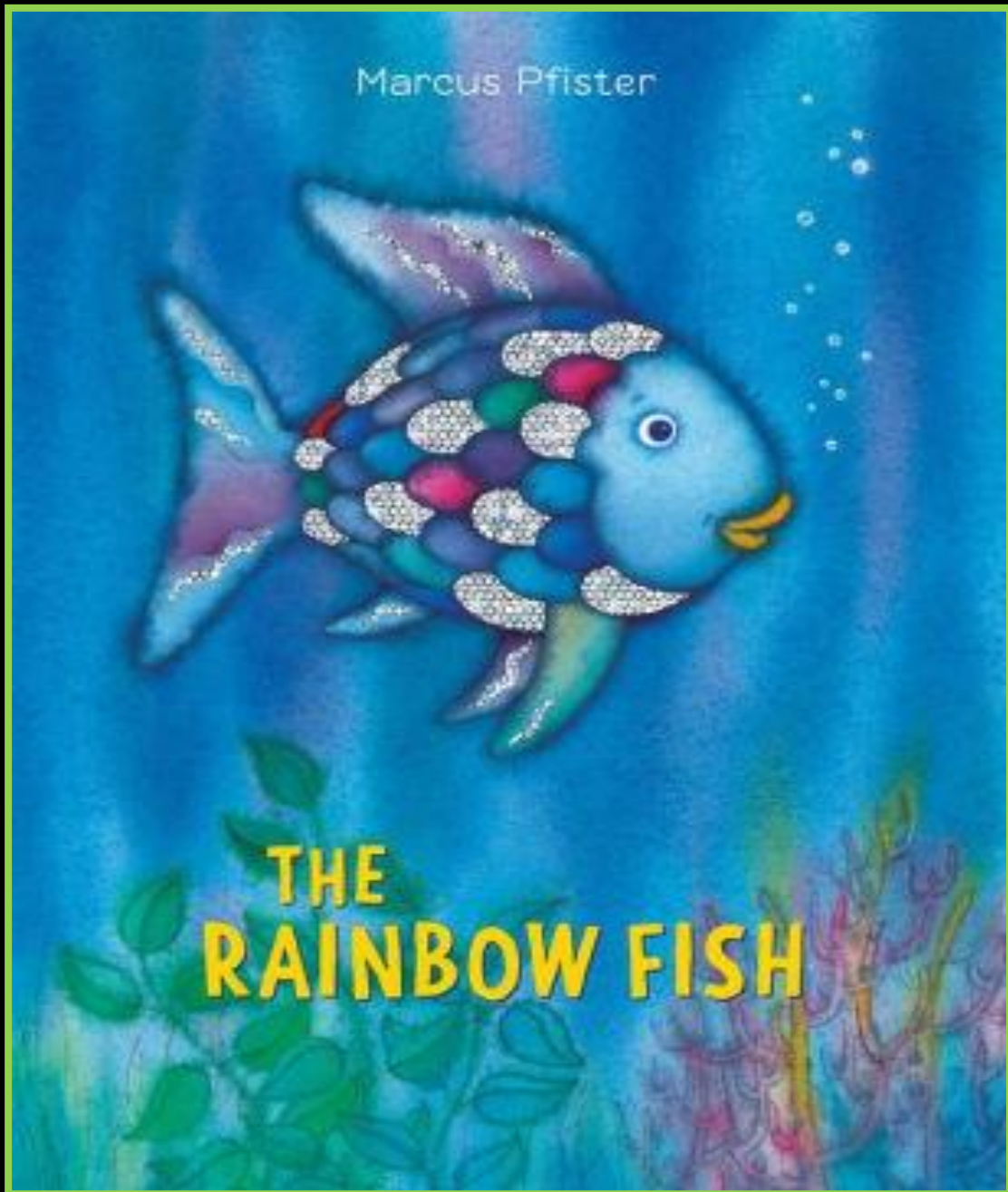

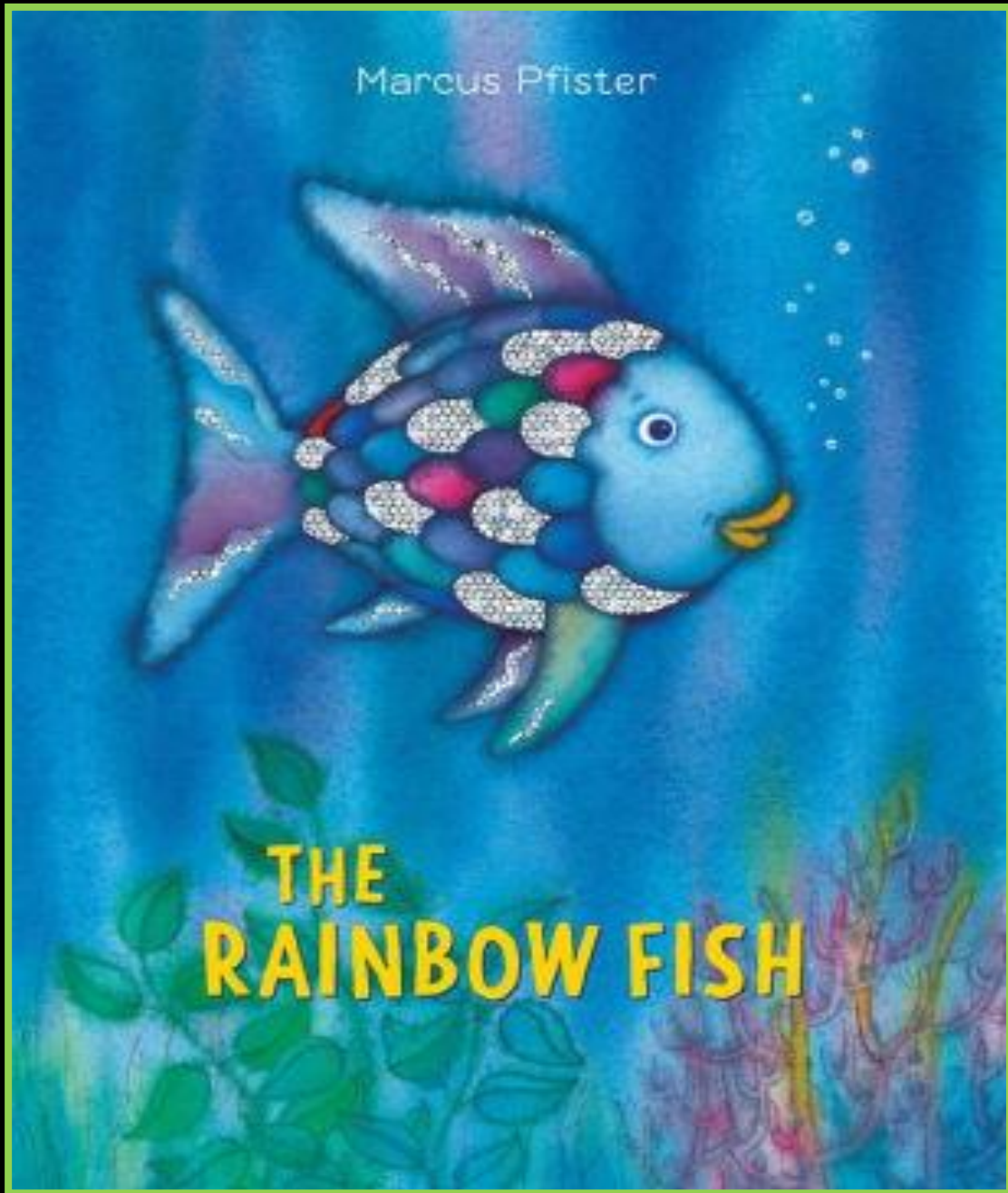




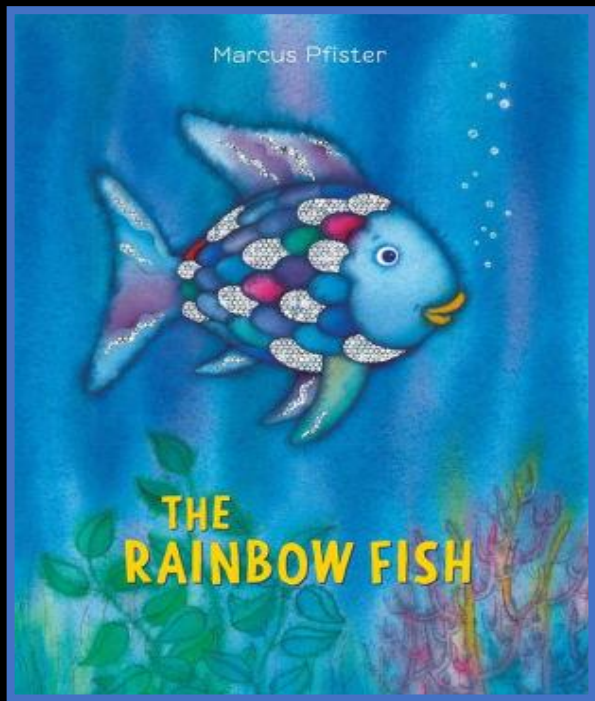
